Water Park Fun & More option entitles guest to a specified number of visits (between 2 and 10) to a choice of entertainment and recreation venues. Choices are Disney's Blizzard Beach water park, Disney's Typhoon Lagoon water park, DisneyQuest, Pleasure Island, Disney's Wide World of Sports.

No expiration means unused admissions on a ticket have no expiration date. All tickets expire 14 days after first use unless *No Expiration* is purchased.
